The teacher is responsible for music instruction, studio management, participation in the work of the strings department, including attending faculty meetings and engagement in the overall work and mission of the Concord Conservatory of Music. The instructor will also lead group classes as part of the West Side Strings Program.

- Maintain high standards of teaching excellence; including fostering a positive learning environment that
 is student-centered, establishing a good rapport with students and families, encouraging open
 discussion and creating a positive atmosphere.
- Support the artistic and educational development of each student by proactively recommending their
 participation in the many educational programs that CCM offers to students. Many such programs will
 enhance the student's experience and make their music education at CCM complete and meaningful.
- Create and prepare appropriate lesson and class materials that are in accordance with the given curriculum area.
- Communicate with students and families regarding student's progress and future directions, scheduling, and related administrative policies.
- Promptly return phone calls and messages to students, families and CCM administration.
- Maintain consistent schedule of teaching following the CCM guidelines.
- Keep accurate attendance records.
- Attend faculty meeting(s) by the department or program schedule.
- Keep absences to a minimum adhering to the teacher absence policy.
- Two afternoons of teaching that include private lessons and West Side Strings group classes.
- · Participation in recitals and concerts

- Teachers must have experience, intuition, and enthusiasm for working with young children as well as exceptional skills communicating with parents, and the more advanced students of all ages.
- Preferred qualifications: M.A in music with an emphasis on pedagogy & performance, significant performance experience, 4+ years of studio teaching experience
