The instructor works with the CCM team to expand the Musical Kids program and maintain retention. Starting date is September 2023 with demo classes scheduled prior to the fall semester.

## **Responsibilities**

- Candidates will be responsible for teaching children ages 3 to 5 years in age
- Evaluating the needs of each section and developing the program accordingly
- Collaboration with CCM Early Childhood instructors
- Communicate with parents as requested to educate, increase retention, and market CCM's Musical Kids
- Two teaching days, including Saturday mornings.

## **Qualifications**

### **Education:**

- Minimum BA in music or music education, BA in an arts-related area with demonstrated proficiency in music (singing, reading music, rhythm, a basic understanding of classroom instruments, etc.), Dalcroze certificate is required. Completion of an early childhood training program such as Orff and Kodaly are welcomed.

### **Experience:**

- Teachers must have experience, intuition, and enthusiasm for working with young children as well as exceptional skills communicating with parents.
- Minimum of 3 years of teaching experience in the classroom setting with young children ages 3-6 years old.
- Candidates must be organized and detail-oriented.

### **Knowledge and Skills:**

Knowledge about early childhood development. Demonstrated age-appropriate classroom management skills. Positive, energetic attitude and strong professionalism. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with children and adults. Must be motivated, collaborative, and committed to early childhood music education.
