The ideal candidate can teach an array of different classes, including songwriting, music production, and composition. The instructor must be adept at teaching both children and adults. All teaching will take place in the Concord Conservatory of Music's new media lab.

Faculty members are responsible for delivering high-quality music education, managing their studios, and contributing to departmental initiatives. Responsibilities also include attending faculty meetings and supporting CCM's mission. The ideal candidate is an experienced educator with a passion for community-based music education and the ability to teach a wide range of classes.

We would also like to add a few hours of lab monitoring to this role. During lab hours, students are welcome to use the space, but we require a staff member to be present to supervise their work and assist with any technical questions.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach engaging group classes for students at various skill levels, from beginner to advanced.
- Develop lesson plans and tailor instruction to accommodate diverse learning styles.
- Participate in faculty recitals, community outreach programs, and conservatory events.
- Support CCM's mission by attending occasional workshops, student recitals, and faculty meetings.
- Fulfill general faculty duties as outlined in the Faculty Handbook..

- Deep knowledge of music production and experience **working with DAWs** (knowledge of Logic Pro is highly desirable).
- Knowledge of basic recording techniques.
- Songwriting skills are not necessary, but would be highly appreciated.
- Excellent communication skills, particularly when working with parents and advanced students.
- A commitment to fostering a collaborative and professional learning environment.

Preferred qualifications: M.A. in music with an emphasis on music production, 2+ years of teaching experience
